

# THE NANTUCKET UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

COMPLETED IN 1823 THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF NANTUCKET (NOW THE NANTUCKET UNITED METHODIST CHURCH) STANDS AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF CENTRE AND LIBERTY STREETS. SIGNIFICANT ALTERATIONS HAVE BEEN: THE ADDITION OF A GREEK REVIVAL FACADE AND A TWO PITCHED GABLE ROOF OVER THE EXISTING FOUR PITCHED HIP ROOF IN 1840, RECONFIGURATION OF PULPIT AND PEW ORIENTATION FROM EAST TO WEST IN 1844, INSTALLATION OF THE APPLETON PIPE ORGAN IN 1859, CONSTRUCTION IN 1904 OF A SECOND FLOOR CHAPEL ABOVE THE VESTIBULE AND EXTENDING INTO THE SANCTUARY AT THE BALCONY LEVEL, AND THE COMPLETION IN 1970 OF THE BASEMENT EXCAVATION ALLOWING CONSTRUCTION OF THE FELLOWSHIP HALL.

THIS DOCUMENTATION PROJECT WAS PART OF THE 1998 SUMMER SESSION OF THE PRESERVATION INSTITUTE NANTUCKET, AN ACADEMIC PROGRAM OF THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA COLLEGE OF ARCHITECTURE.
